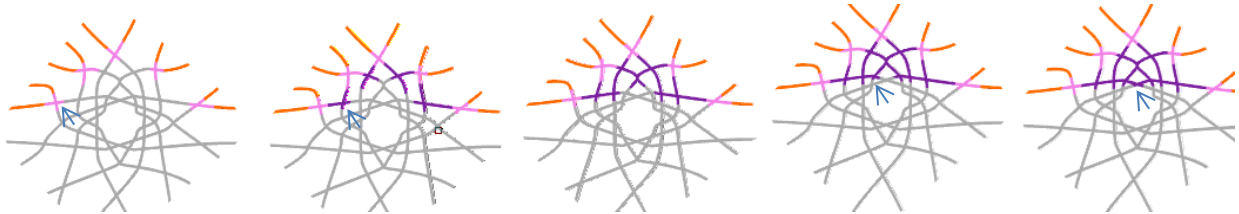


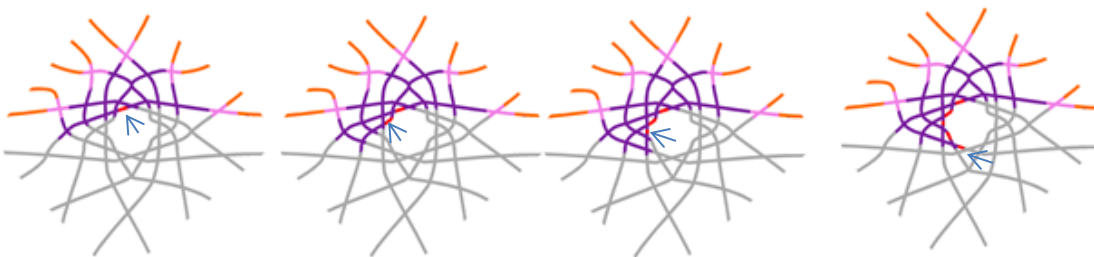
The large star with 10 pairs

You work in 4 parts :

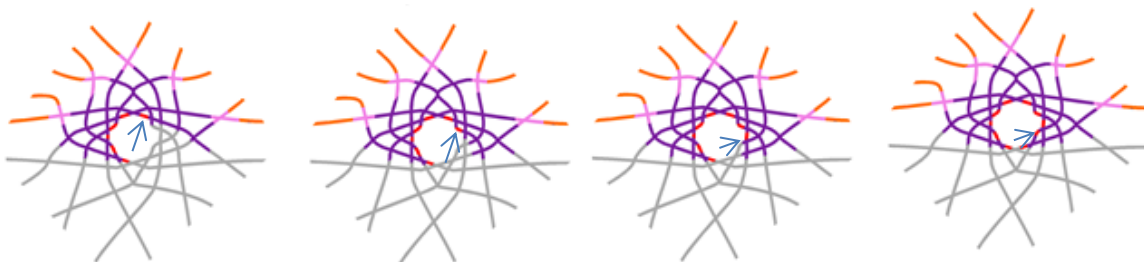
Upper center: Twist all pairs 2 X (orange) and cross 2 neighbors (pink). Starting with the second and third pair, you work in the first row 4 cloth stitches always using two new neighbored pairs there is no weaver, second row 3, third row 2 and last row 1 cloth stitch, 4 pins instead of one in the center to keep the hole wide open.



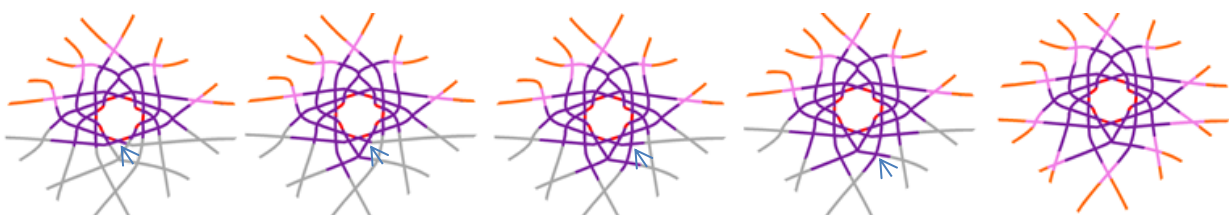
Left: Starting in the center, twist always the weavers (red) first then work first row 4 cloth stitches (purple), second row 3, third row 2 and last row one cloth stitch toward the left direction; twist the remaining pair.



Right: opposite way. Starting in the center twist always the weavers (red) then work first row 4 cloth stitches, second row 3, third row 2 and last row one cloth stitch toward the right direction; twist the remaining pair.



Lower center: Starting (no more twists to the weavers) in the middle at the blue arrow. First row 4 cloth stitches toward the left direction, second row 3, third row 2, last row 1 cloth stitch
Cross (pink) two neighbored pairs. Twist all the pairs twice.



Pull the threads **delicately** in several passes. The 4 pins help, to keep the hole open, otherwise the threads would tighten too soon. Finally you take the 4 pins away and put a single pin, pull again.
